```
1 from datary import Datary
2 d = Datary(username='test_user', password='test_password')
```

1.2.2 Init using user token

```
1 from datary import Datary
2 d = Datary(token='test_token')
```

1.3 Repository Methods

1.3.1 Create repo

```
1 from datary import Datary
2 d = Datary(username='test_user', password='test_password')
3 d.create_repo(repo_name='repo_test',
4               repo_category='datary_repo_category', # other as default
5               description='repo description test', # repo_name description as default
6               visibility='datary_visibility_option', # commercial as default
7               license='license_test' # proprietary as default
8               )
